Motion by Daugherty, seconded by Knisely, to approve the contract with CAMCO for Occupational/Physical Therapy for \$59/hour for the period August 1, 2018 to July 31, 2020. Motion unanimously passed by roll call vote.

Motion by Repko, seconded by Barnes, to approve the contract amendment with CenturyLink to upgrade our Enhanced Ethernet to 1 Gig; other contract terms will remain unchanged. The additional cost, net of ERATE reimbursement, will be \$160/month. Motion unanimously passed by roll call vote.

Mr. Burket discussed Legislative updates.

Mr. Puskar provided his Secondary Principal's report (attached).

Mr. Hall provided his Elementary Principal's report (attached). He also presented a report on reading scores at the Elementary School.

Mr. Hall provided his Federal Programs report (attached).

Mr. McLaurin reported that teachers from both buildings participated in a space balloon launch at the IU on Monday. Administration is working on plans to add coffee bar/alternative breakfast location in the Secondary building. He attended the Rotary meeting on Tuesday evening. Administration met with the Education Foundation last week to discuss alternative funding sources. CK is currently using a demonstration of "My Access", this uses artificial intelligence to help student improve writing skills. Mr. McLaurin thanked the student body/staff/administration for helping put together the recognition service this morning.

Motion by Burket, seconded by Barnes, to amend item 1a to note the correction in the date – the early dismissal date will be March 29<sup>th</sup>, not April 29<sup>th</sup>. Motion passed by voice vote.
