POSITION VOLUNTEER CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

There are federal and state laws that protect the privacy rights of students and families. In a school situation, there are many instances in which confidential information is discussed in order to better understand students and how we can help them. When working in the schools as a volunteer, there may be times when this information is overheard. Our staff will make every effort to prevent this from happening; however, as a volunteer you must agree that if you do hear information about a student or family, you will not repeat this outside of the school. This will ensure the protection of our students' interest and their families and will create a better environment for everyone.

Additionally, there are three laws that govern special education confidentiality. All three regulations indicate that confidentiality must be maintained in relation to special education students

- FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act).
- IDEIA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act).
- Chapter 14 (Pennsylvania Special Education Guidelines).

Therefore, any written or verbal communication with anyone who does not have a right to know is in violation of these laws. A volunteer should not discuss a student's disability with any individual outside of the classroom instructor, building principal, or staff member. The volunteer should not carry any written statements or repeat any verbal statements that would divulge the student's disability outside of the school. In essence, only those who work directly with the student are considered as those with a "need to know."

If at any time these terms of confidentiality are violated by a volunteer, the Building Principal reserves the right to deny or remove any volunteer violating confidentiality.

By signing this Confidentiality Agreement, I am stating that I will not divulge information about any student or family to any person that does not work directly with the student or to anyone outside of the school.
